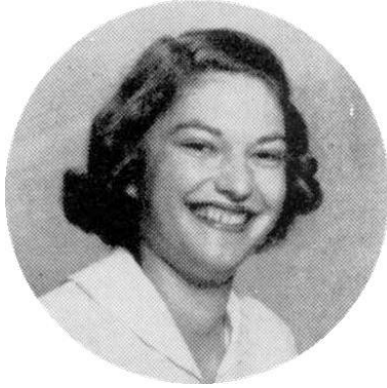


Diane May [Litton] Davis
