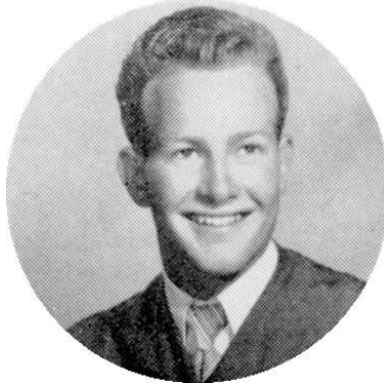


Carl Robert Willhoft
